## APPOSITIVES

An appositive is a group of words that explains something in a sentence.

**Example:** His pet, *that tiny turtle*, is under the chair.

An appositive is placed next to the word it explains.

**Example:** Kim has a toy, *a pink and blue top*.

An appositive is set off by commas.

**Example:** Joanie, *my best friend*, likes to skate.



Directions: Place the appositive by the word it explains.

**Example:** Fluffy is their cat. Fluffy is black and white.

Fluffy, **their cat**, is black and white.
