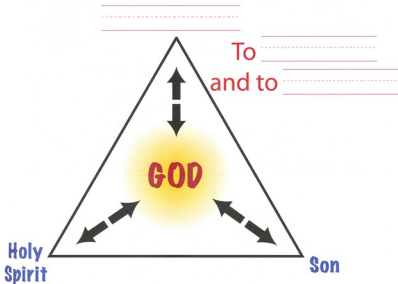
Color the picture of the Passover.

LESSON 4 Activities

- 1. Make a ball or “globe” using blue Play-Doh®. Use a flashlight to represent the light, and shine it on the “globe.”
- 2. Write God’s name at the top of the “Trinity triangle” and include His jobs. (Answers: **Father** [top line], **create, command**)



- 3. Turn to page 91 of this *Activity Book*. Find Day 1, and color the top half of the “world” yellow for the light and the bottom half black for the darkness for the timeline of creation.

SOMETHING ELSE TO DO

- ✱ Learn Matthew 22:37–40 (NKJV). Memorize the words in **bold**.

Jesus said to him, **“‘You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.”**

- ✱ Learn the meaning of the vocabulary word “selfish.” Add the word **selfish** to your Memory Game.
- ✱ Think of different ways you can serve someone in your family. Choose one way to serve, and then serve one family member this week.

FURTHER STUDY:

- ✱ Read Luke 10:30–37. This story is called the parable of the Good Samaritan.
 - What happened to the man who went down from Jerusalem to Jericho?
 - Who came by first? What did he do to help the man?
 - Who came by second? What did he do to help the man?
 - Who came by third? What did he do to help the man?
 - What did the Good Samaritan do the next day when he had to leave?
 - Which one was a neighbor to the man who fell among the thieves?
 - How does this parable help us understand Mark 12:33?
- ✱ As time permits, you may choose to go over other examples in the Bible of people who served others.
 - Joseph serves Potiphar (Genesis 39:1–6)
 - Ruth serves her mother-in-law, Naomi (Ruth 1:15–18; 2:11, 12)
 - Jesus serves the disciples by washing their feet (John 13:1–5)
 - The early church in Acts (Acts 2:42–47)
