A lot of book lists are simply collections of the titles everyone "must read." While there are books so good they genuinely belong on such lists, there are plenty more that are only famous because so many people have declared them to be. In a picture book, it could be as simple as uniquely drawn backgrounds; in a novel, it could be an awesome opening line; or it could be an ideal friendship, intelligent humor, or family-friendly warm fuzzies.

So, this isn't a list designed to prove what great taste we have. It's intended to share our love of reading with you, and to show that not all good books have to be the kind students and critics dissect at university. The best books are the ones that reach into your brain and heart and fiddle with the strings, pulling you into a different shape and giving you one more perspective on the world you wouldn't have enjoyed on your own.
