Lesson 10

Date:

- 1. Discuss the accomplishments of Leif Erikson despite his limited resources. Did Leif provide us with a good example of a Christian leader? Was he brave? Helpful? Obedient to parents? Diligent in spreading the gospel?
- 2. Color the picture in notebook.

Lesson 11

Date:

- 1. Introduce *Columbus* by Ingri and Edgar Parin D'Aulaire. Read pages 4 thru 9. For a richer and more enjoyable study, it is recommended that the book, *The Light and the Glory* by Peter Marshall be read, pages 29 thru 66.
 - a. Columbus is another special individual God used in the discovery of America.
 - b. Methods of navigation now include the compass.
- 2. Columbus worked on improving his skill as a sailor by learning astronomy, geometry, arithmetic, drafting spherical maps, etc.
- 3. Contrast the time of Columbus with the time of Erikson (500 years ago vs 1000 years ago).
- 4. Record in notebook, "Columbus was born in Genoa, Italy, about 500 years ago." Find Genoa on a globe or map.
- 5. Paste picture from page 9 of text into notebook of Columbus holding the orange. Title it, "Columbus believes the world is round."

Lesson 12

Date:

- 1. Read pages 10 thru 17 of Columbus.
 - a. Discuss how Columbus' faith in God is demonstrated by his thankfulness to God for sparing his life.
 - b. Columbus learns eagerly the saga of Leif Erikson, and he becomes convinced that lands lay to the west.
 - c. Columbus feels called by God to sail to these lands to bring the Gospel and to find the vast riches of the East.
