DATE:

1. Read Wilfrid Gordon McDonald Partridge by Mem Fox, illustrated by Julie Vivas.
2. Wilfrid helps his friend Miss Nancy in a very meaningful way. What are ways that you can help those around you? Write down three things you can do for someone you care about and do them. How did helping other people make you feel?
3. Read Leviticus 19:32. We are commanded to respect our elders and by doing so show reverence to God. What are things that you can do to show respect to the elderly?
