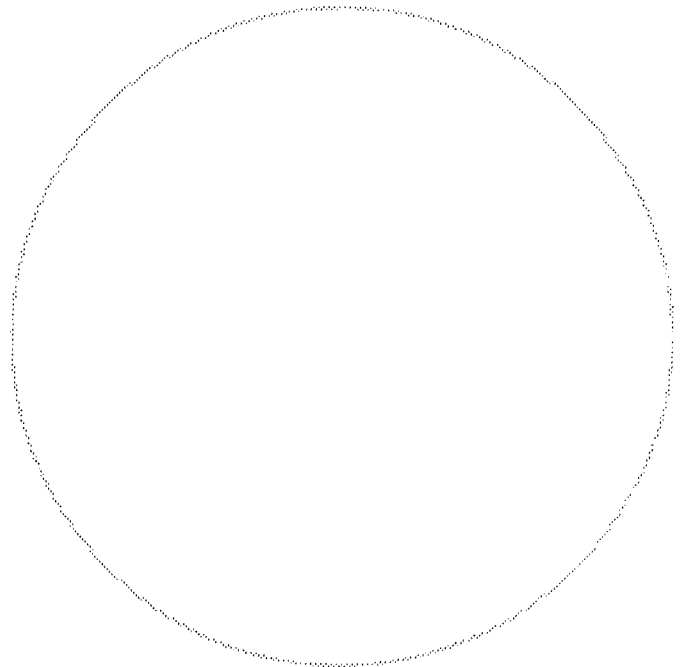

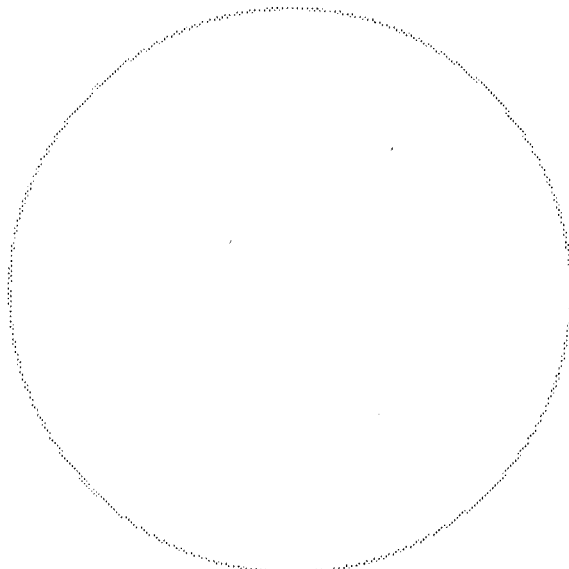
Cut out the pictures on pages 119-121 and paste them into the correct circle. Each circle represents a day in God's creation.



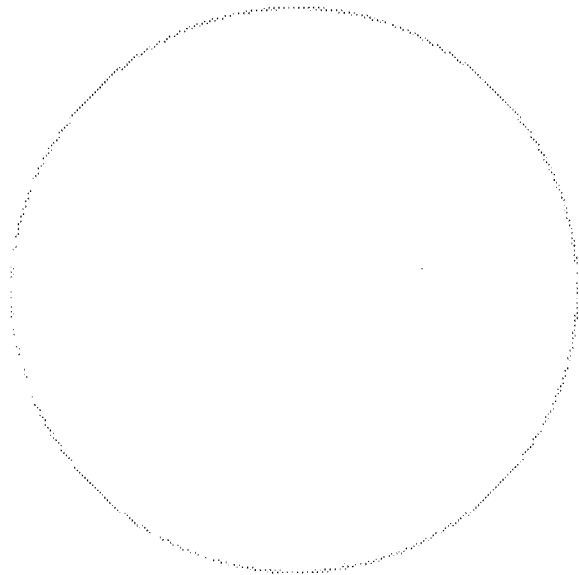
