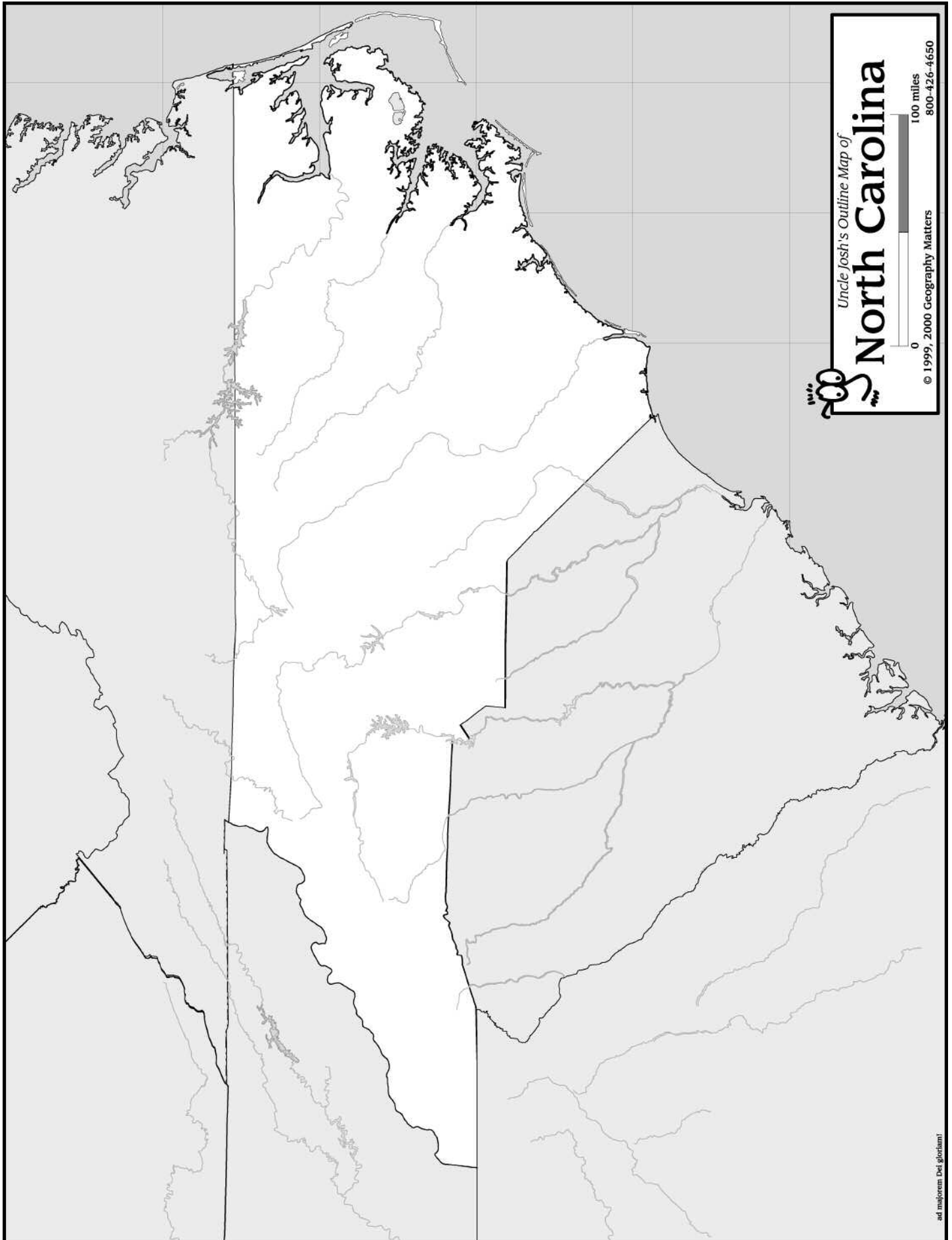
North Carolina

- Shade and label any state park of interest in purple.
- Label Virginia, Tennessee, Georgia, South Carolina, and Atlantic Ocean.

Uncle Josh's Outline Map of

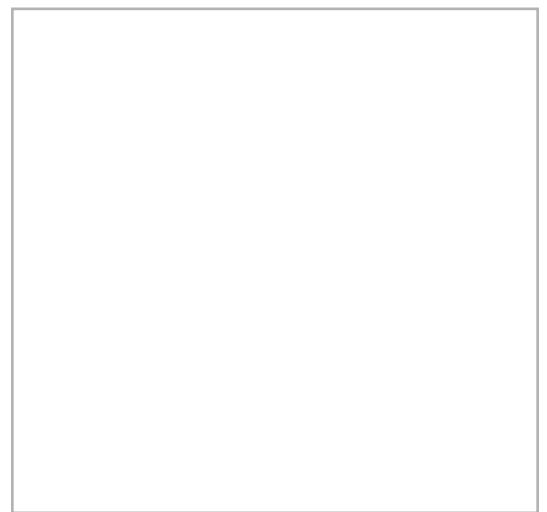
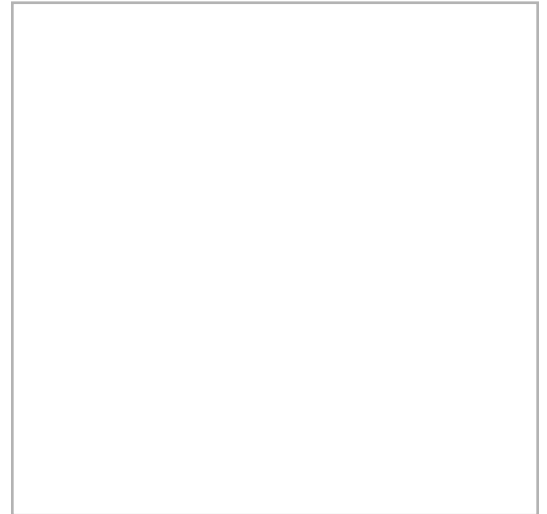
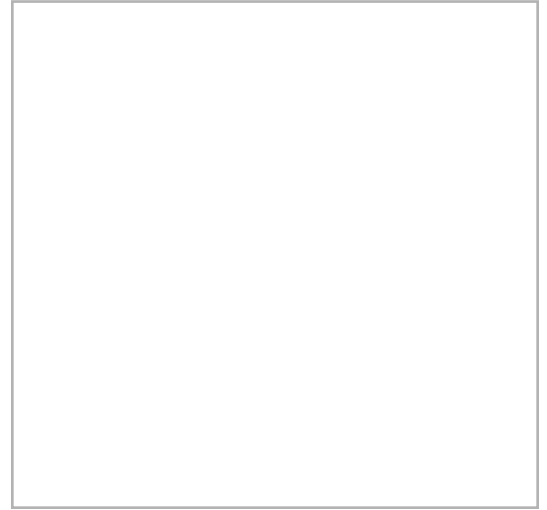

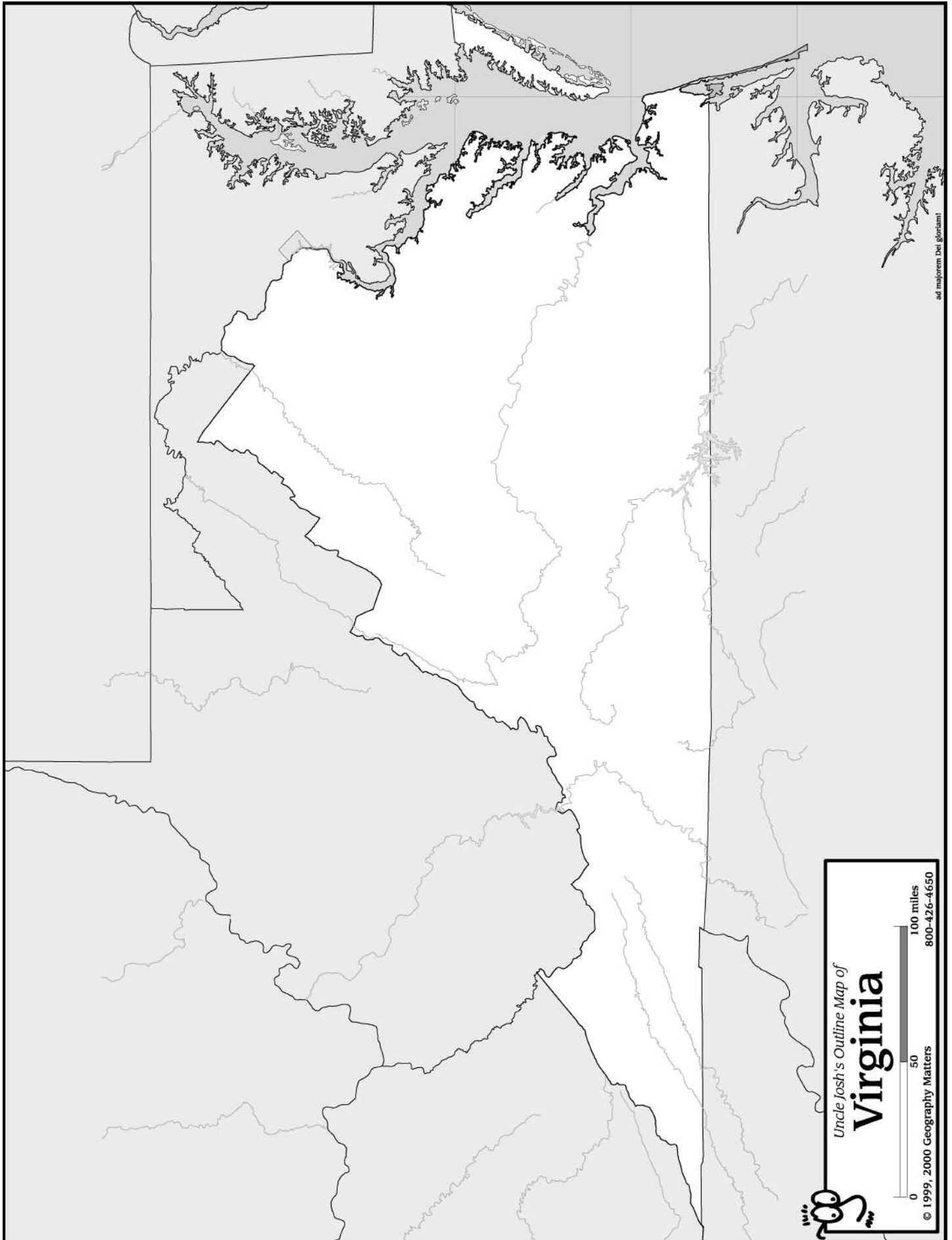

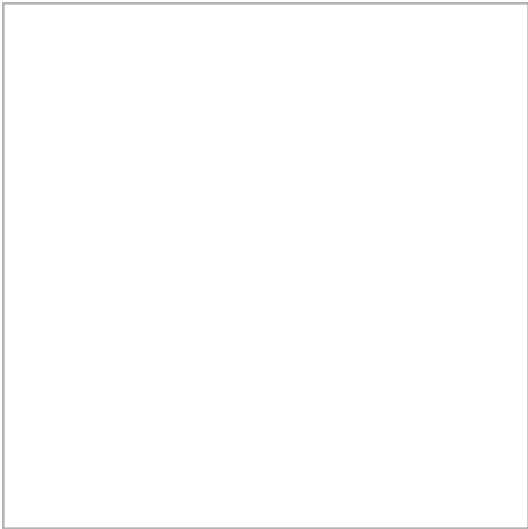
