### CAPITALIZATION:

Capitalize the name of a book if the title is only one word.

Example: the book, Weasel

1. his mom read bambi\* to him.

\*name of a book

### PUNCTUATION:

If one person or thing owns something, add 's.

Example: one hamster's cage

2. a car belonging to her dad = her \_\_\_\_\_ car

### PREFIXES/ROOTS/SUFFIXES:

A root is any word without a part added at the beginning or at the end.

Examples: smoothly = smooth (root) + ly (suffix)

remake = re (prefix) + make (root)
