**PARTS OF SPEECH: VERBS**

**Linking verbs do not show action. However, some verbs can serve as an action verb or as a linking verb.**

Hint: In deciding if a verb is action or linking, try placing *is, am, are, was, or were* in its place. If it doesn't change the sentence meaning, it's usually linking.

**are**

Example: You appear very angry. (*Appear* is a linking verb here.)
