SENTENCE TYPES

There are four types of sentences.

 A declarative sentence makes a statement. A declarative sentence ends with a period.

Examples: John Glenn was one of our first astronauts.

This caramel apple tastes good.

Paseo Verde Elementary School is new.

An interrogative sentence asks a question. An interrogative sentence ends with a question mark.

Examples: Have you ever been to a fair?

What's your name?

Did your friend move to lowa?

 An imperative sentence gives a command. An imperative sentence ends with a period.

Examples: Put this in the kitchen, please.

Write your name on the paper.

Eat before you leave.

 An exclamatory sentence shows emotion. An exclamatory sentence ends with an exclamation point (mark).

Examples: The ice cream man is here!

Stop!

Slow Down! You're driving too fast!
