STEWART H. HOLBROOK was born in Vermont, served with a New England regiment of field artillery in France during World War I, then migrated to the American West where he has lived for more than thirty years. He worked three years in Northwestern logging camps, then became a newspaper reporter and ranged over much of the West. He now writes and makes his home in Portland, Oregon. Among his previous books for young people are *America's Ethan Allen*, *Wild Bill Hickok Tames the West* and *Davy Crockett*, the latter two in the Landmark series.
