ALISTAIR MacLEAN is the author of many novels of adventure and intrigue. He has also written several mysteries under various pseudonyms. One of his most popular books, *The Guns of Navarone*, served as the basis for a highly successful film.

Mr. MacLean has traveled in the Middle East, the scene of T. E. Lawrence's World War I experiences. And after the Second World War he wrote a series of articles on desert warfare in North Africa for a British newspaper, the *Sunday Dispatch*.
