A. GROVE DAY has been living since 1944 in Hawaii, where he is Professor of English at the University of Hawaii in Honolulu. In 1955 he went to Australia on a Fulbright research grant and studied Australian literature. He spent a whole year traveling about the continent, visiting its historic spots and becoming acquainted with Australians of all ages and walks of life. Much of the research for *The Story of Australia* was done at the Mitchell Library in Sydney, Australia, which has perhaps the world's best collection of books and manuscripts on the Pacific region.

Dr. Day was born in Philadelphia, attended high school in New Jersey, and was graduated from Stanford University in 1926.
