

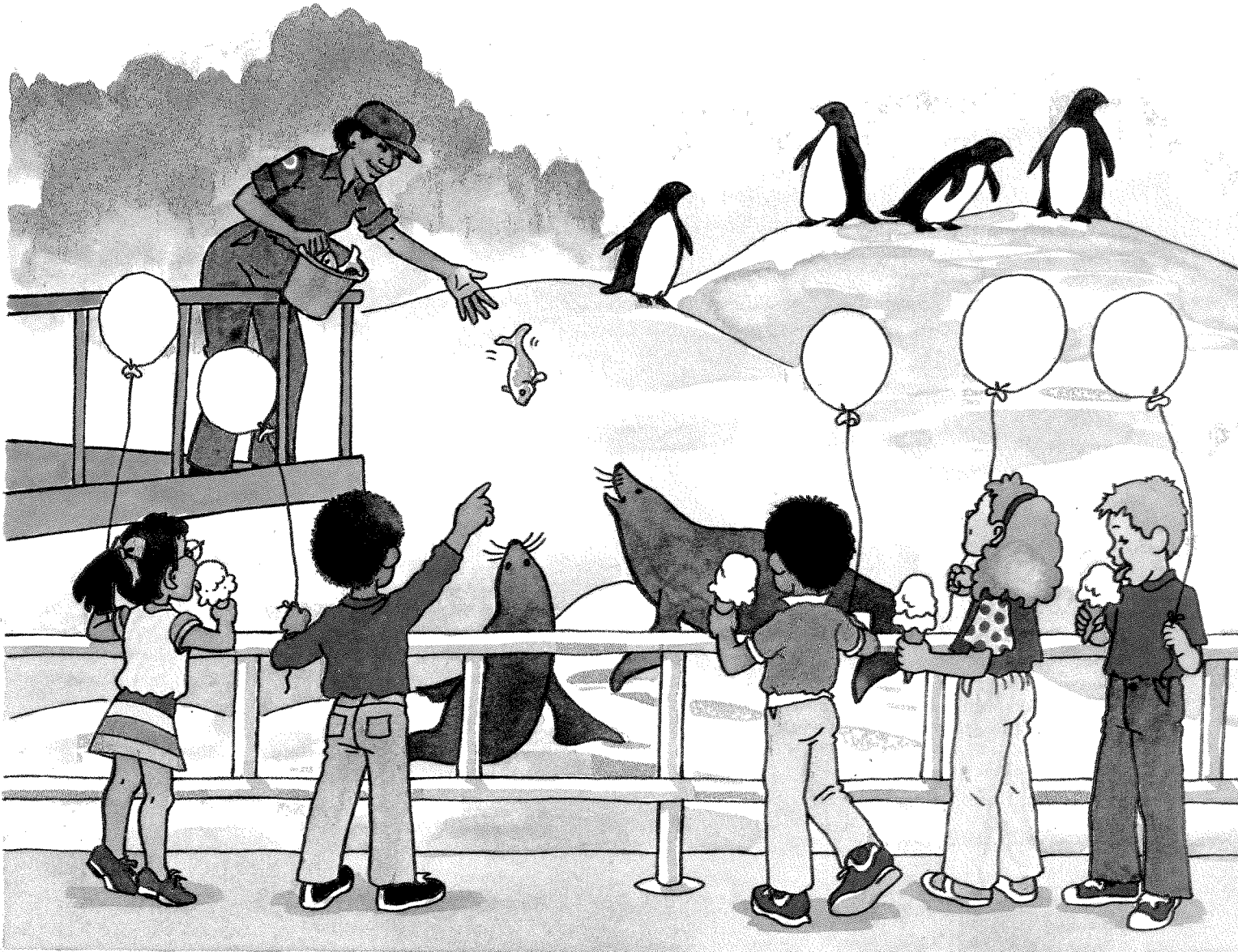

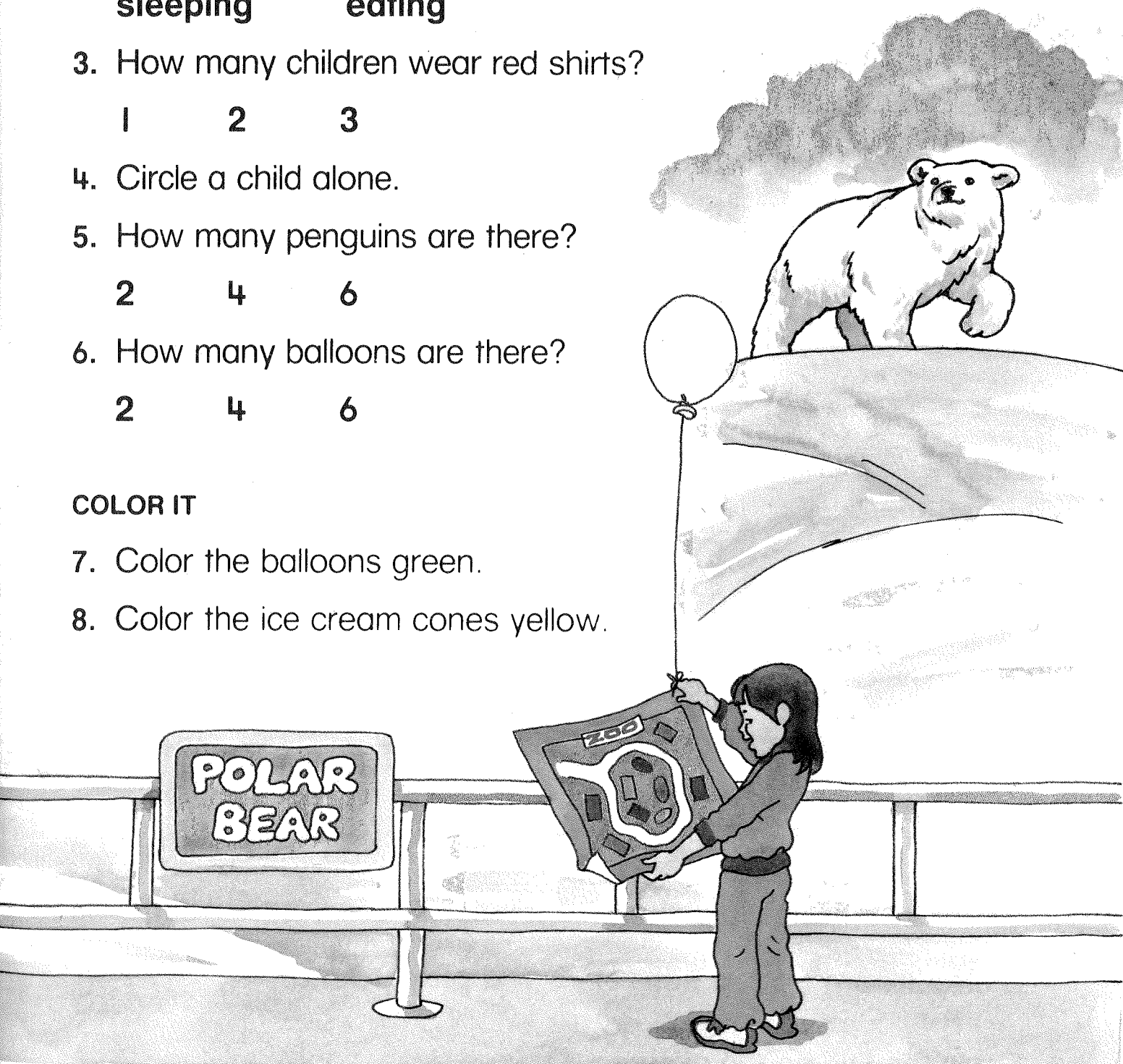

Titles Help Us

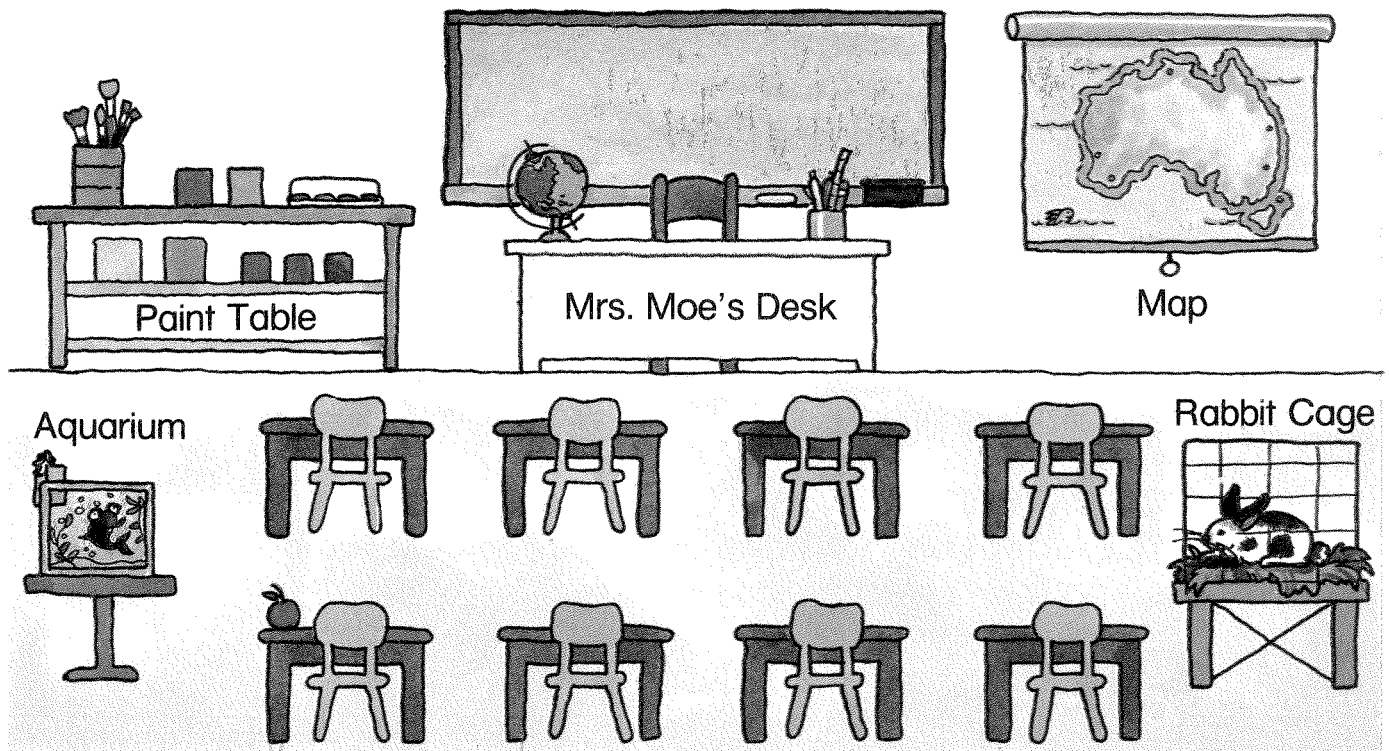
WHAT I WILL LEARN What does a picture title do?

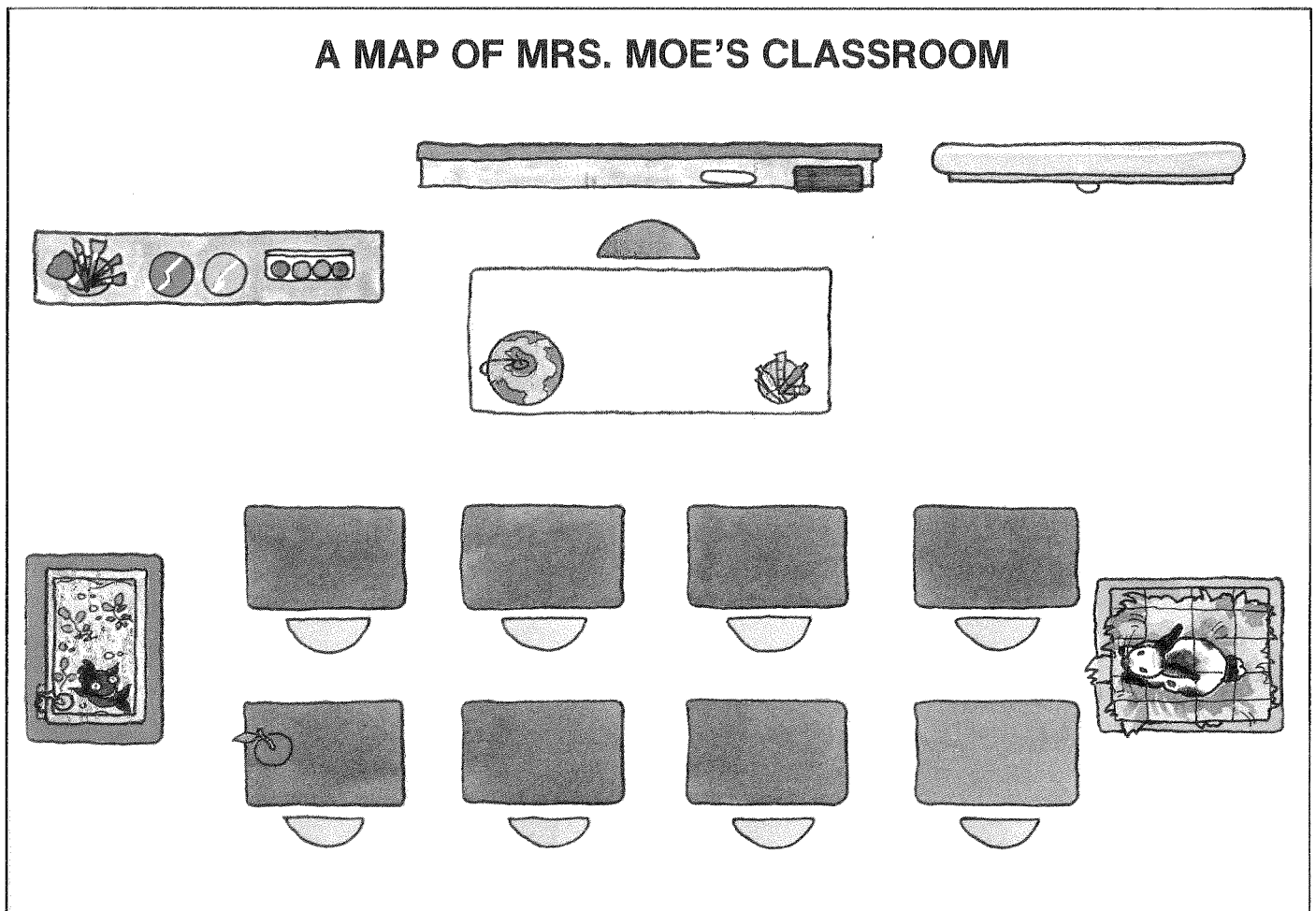
