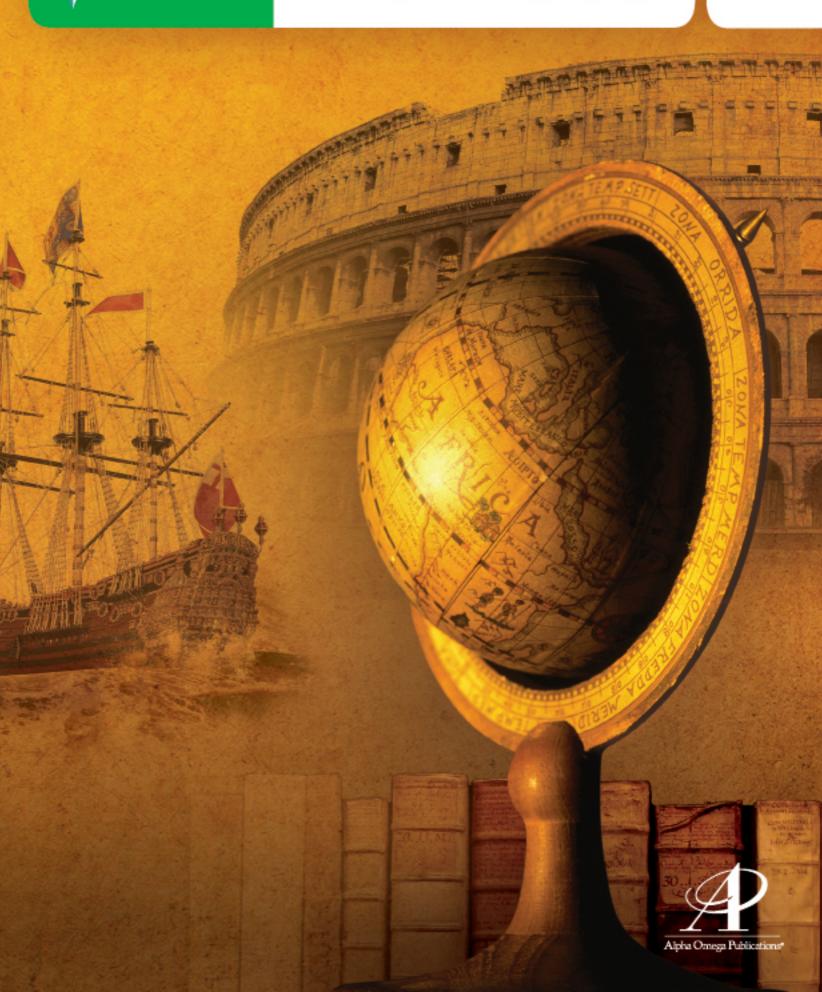




I. PEOPLE DEPEND ON EACH OTHER IN A FAMILY
