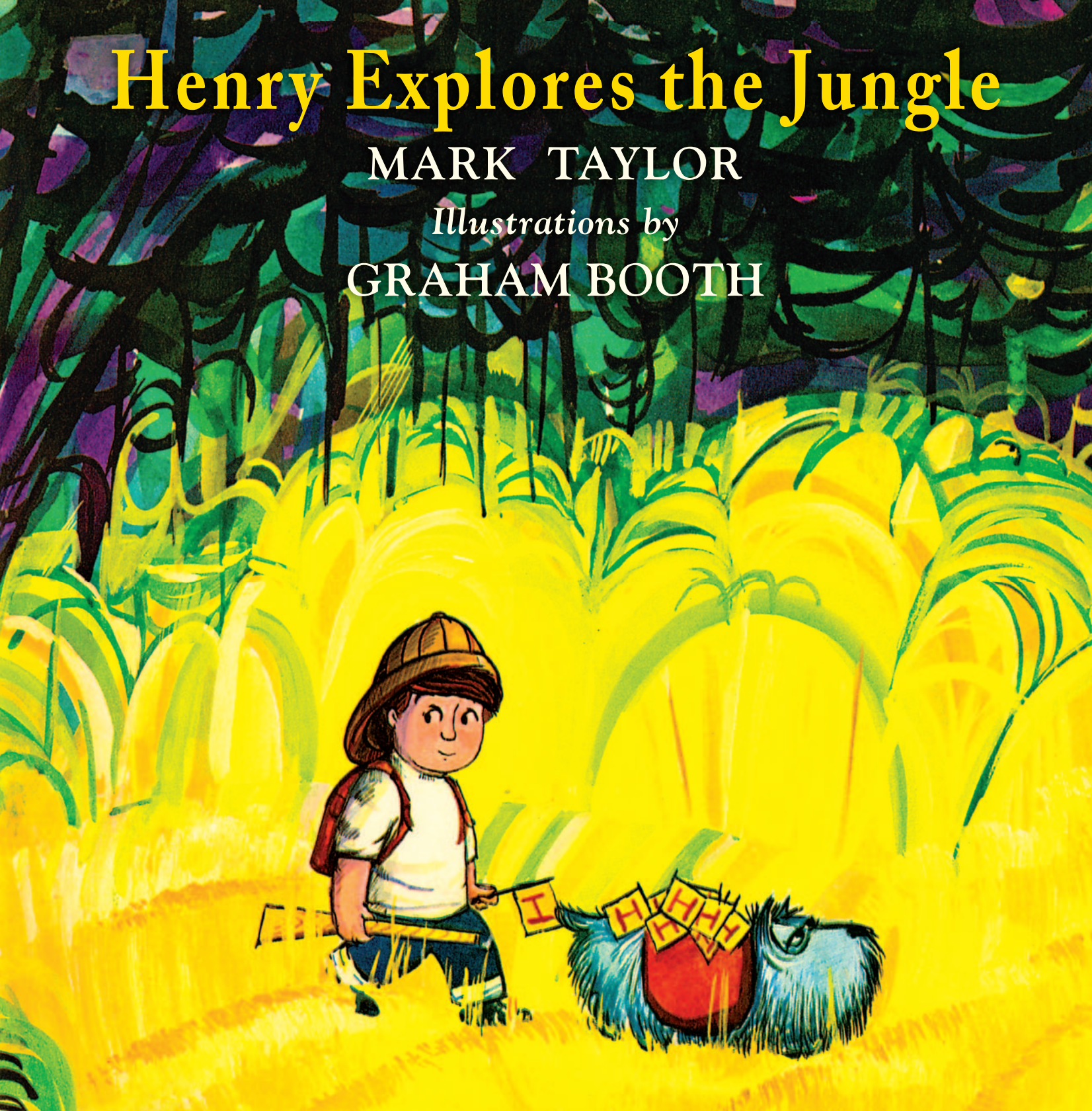

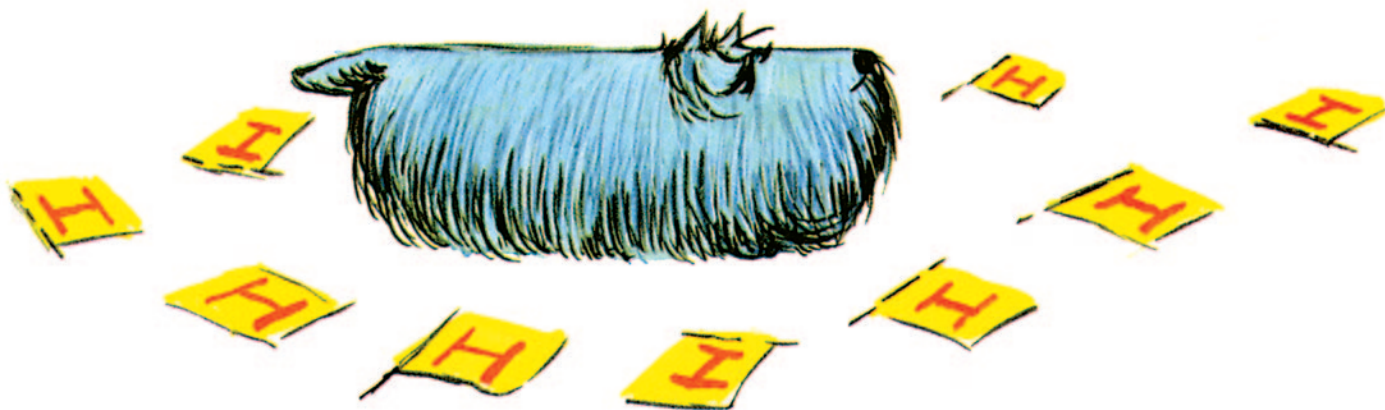

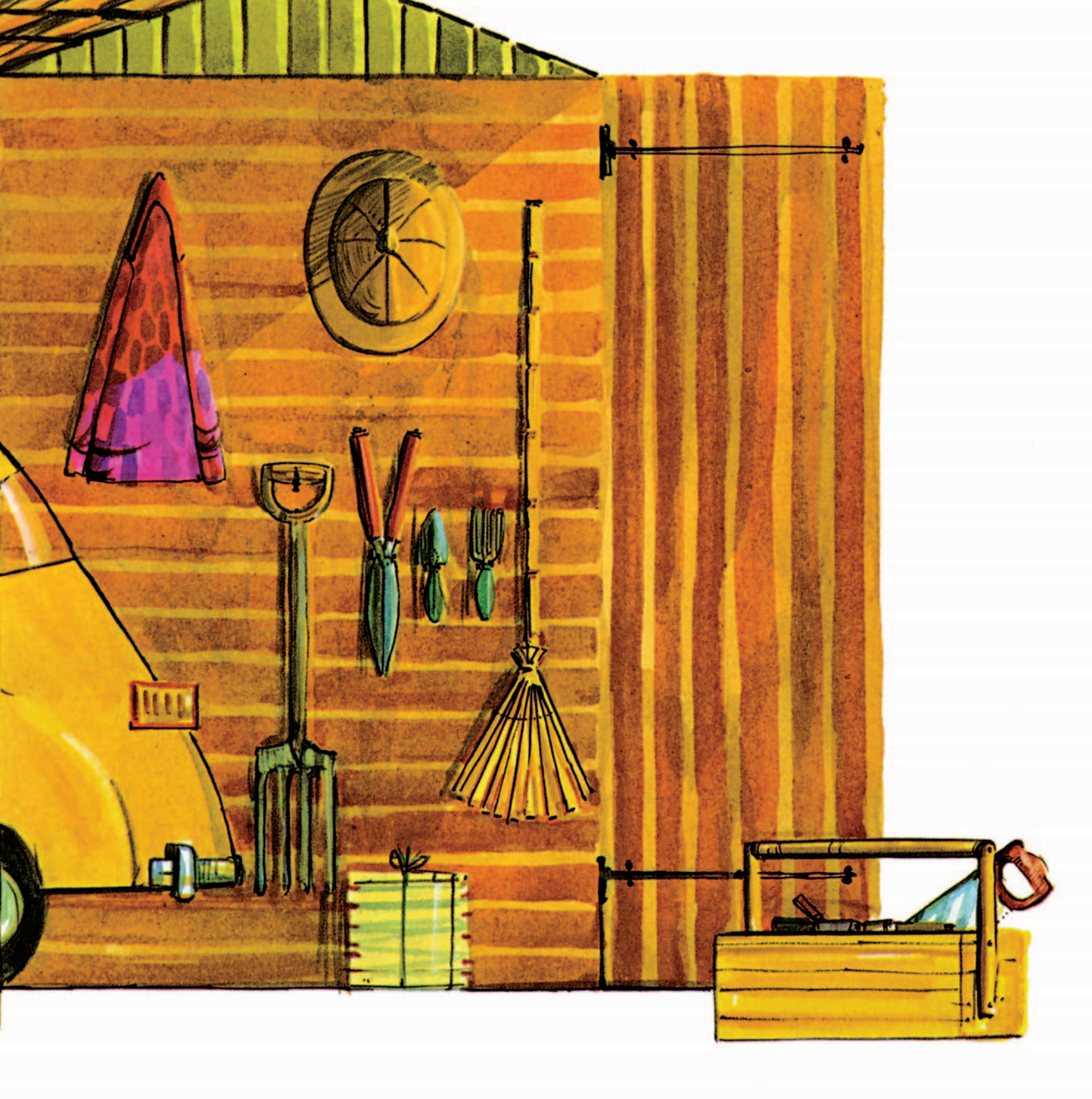
One hot summer morning, Henry and Laird Angus McAngus read their favorite book about jungles.
