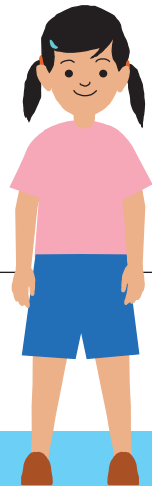
Spot has 3 doggie biscuits.



Objective: Understand that a set with no objects in it is a set of zero.

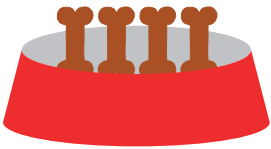
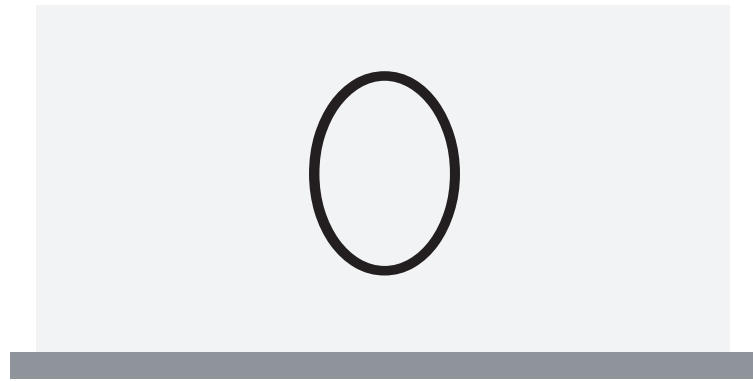


There is a number for none.

This is what zero looks like.



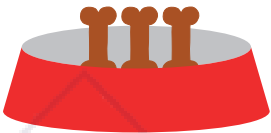
