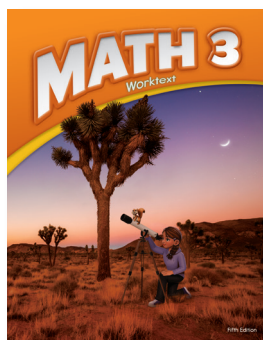

Updates

Learning targets are included on the Student Worktext pages to help students to take ownership of their learning and monitor their progress. At the beginning of each chapter, a detailed lesson plan overview is provided, along with expanded lesson openers to facilitate learning. The Teacher Edition includes larger reduced student pages, and Review book RSPs are now included within the Teacher Edition as well. Differentiated instruction is incorporated near relevant subject matter to address diverse learning needs. Practice and review sections have been moved to the “Apply” section of the teaching cycle to better align with the Student Worktext review content. Additionally, Fact Review pages are recommended for each chapter to aid in math fact memorization. The curriculum also includes expanded biblical worldview shaping that encourages students to approach math from a biblical perspective, with revised chapter opener stories that correlate with these worldview themes.

- Revised chapter opener stories correlate with biblical worldview shaping themes.

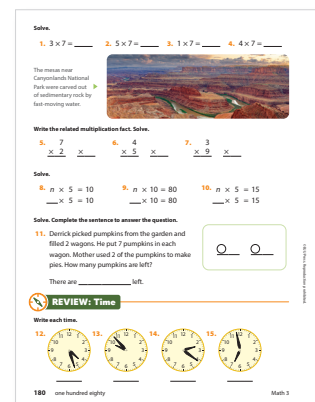
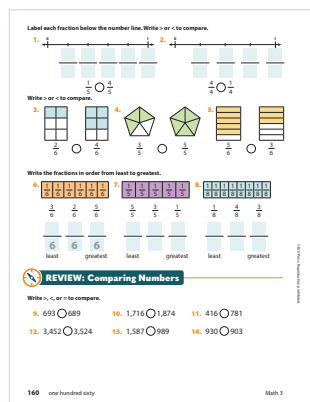
