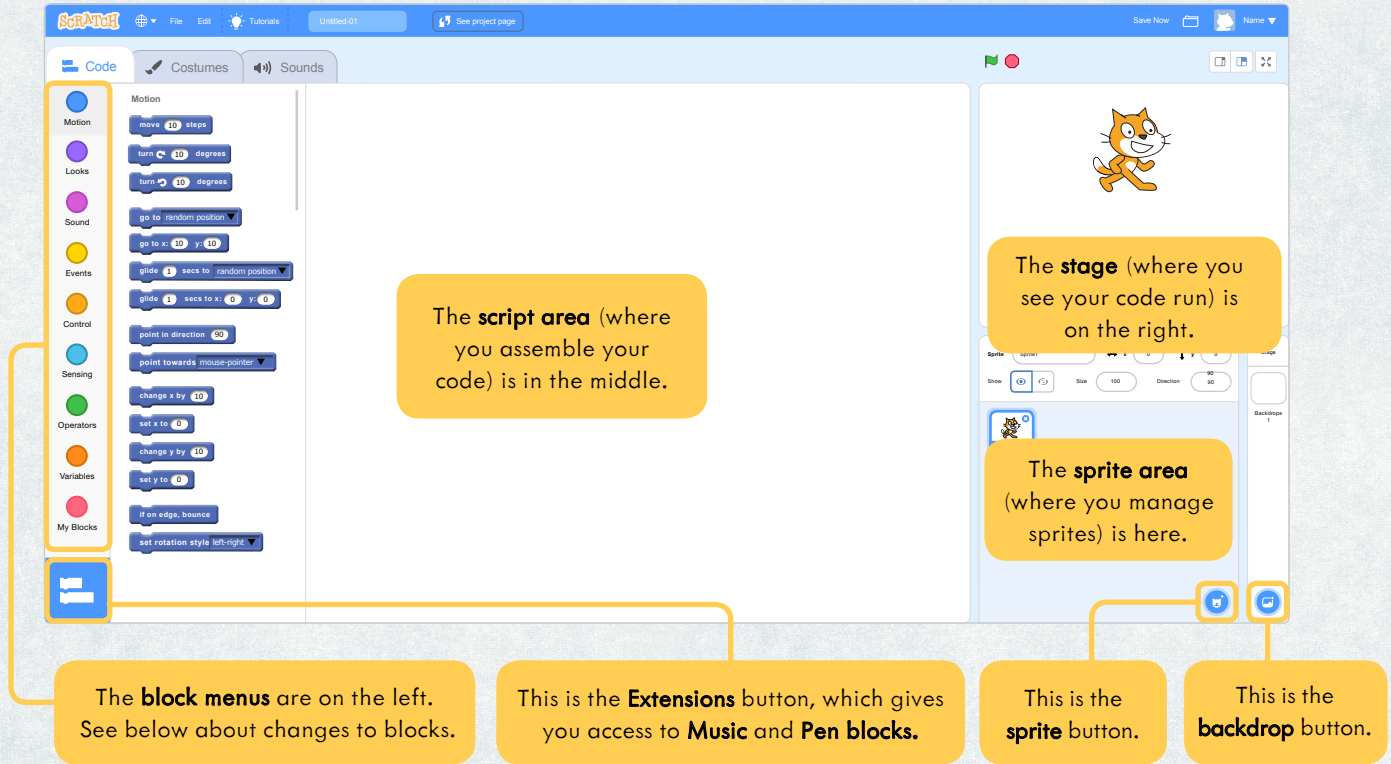


# Using Scratch 3

Scratch 3 is very similar to earlier versions of Scratch. The biggest difference is a new screen layout. Some of the block menus have also been updated.

This is the Scratch 3 screen.



## Block menus

The old **Data** menu is now known as **Variables**.



**More Blocks** is now known as **My Blocks**.



## Block names

The old **play sound** block is now called **start sound**.



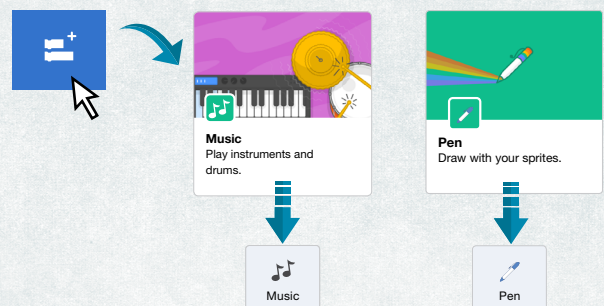
The old **clear** block is now called **erase all** (from **Pen** in **Extensions**.)



## Extensions

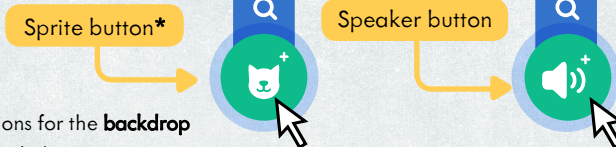
The **Pen** menu and the new **Music** menu are not on the main screen. To access these, click the **Extensions** button at the bottom of the **Block menus**.

Select **Pen** or **Music**, and a new menu will appear below the **Block menus**.



## Accessing tools

To access the **Paint tools**, or to upload a sprite or backdrop, hover the mouse over the **sprite** or **backdrop** button and the options will pop up.



\* The options for the **backdrop** button look the same.

To record or upload sounds, click on the **Sounds** tab at the top of the screen. The **speaker** button will appear at the bottom of the page. Hover the mouse over it to make the options appear.
